

## Sunday Services at the Parkarena with 300 visitors

It is official. Starting in June we'll be able to celebrate our Sunday Services with visitors again. At the moment with a maximum of 300 people and under certain hygiene and distance requirements. Although many things won't be as usual, we are very much looking forward to touching and inspiring moments with you.

### Information about the service and tickets:

- There is a visitor limit of max. 300 people in the park arena.
- A free ticket is required for admission. It can be obtained in advance via the website (Agenda) or our office. Your Ticket must be presented at the entrance.
- Contact details (first and last name, telephone number, email address) must be provided for ticket reservation. This data is stored confidentially and will be completely deleted after a maximum of 30 days.
- The hygiene and distance regulations of the BAG apply for the entire duration of the event (including entry and exit) (e.g. no shaking hands, 2 meters distance, hand disinfection etc.). Sufficient time should therefore be planned for admission.
- People who are sick or who live in the same household with sick people or have had close contact with sick people may not take part in the event. People from particularly vulnerable groups are encouraged to make their own decisions about participation.
- The seats are allocated at the entrance (no free choice of seats). There must be at least 1 seat clearance between the visitors (exception: people who live in the same household). The rows of chairs are at least 1 meter apart. The traceability of the visitors makes it possible to reduce the minimum distance of 2 meters during the service.
- The worship service is subject to certain conditions. E.g. not singing along (hum allowed).
- The 11.15 am service at the Parkarena will be translated in German, English and Portuguese (Livestream with English translation).
- Children's and youth programs are subject to the protection concepts of day care centers and schools. Again, we recommend that you allow enough time for the check-in process.

### Information about other offers (Kids and teens, livestream, groups etc.)

With the easing step from June 6, 2020, in addition to our services, many other offers from different groups are possible again. The requirements of the protection concept also apply in these programs and are implemented according to the circumstances. The agenda on the GvC Winterthur website and the individual channels of the individual offers are continuously updated and provide information about the details.

- The kids and youth programs start again next Sunday and provide separate (mostly on-site) information about any individual regulations. A ticket is also required for the mychurch service.

- The livestream offer will continue to be available to the usual extent (incl. Family podcast). We will go back to streaming the 11:15 am church service. The digital offers are a great alternative to the programs on site - especially for those who cannot or do not want to participate for health or personal reasons or who weren't able to reserve a free ticket. It is also possible to watch the livestream together with friends or the GvC Group at home.
- Small groups and passion groups start individually according to the information of the respective group leader starting June 6th, 2020.
